CERTIFIED / UNCERTIFIED POLICE OFFICER

Applications will be received, by the Town of Wytheville, for the position of full-time Certified/Uncertified Police Officer. **Required Qualifications:** In addition to Town of Wytheville standards, applicants must be 21 years of age, have a high school education, good moral character, and a valid state driver's license. Certified applicants must be in good standing with a Commonwealth of Virginia DCJS Basic Law Enforcement Certification. Uncertified applicants must be able to attend and successfully complete a Commonwealth of Virginia DCJS police academy Law Enforcement Basic Course within one year of employment, must sign a three-year employment contract, and must take and pass a physical agility test that meets the minimum requirements to attend the Basic Law Enforcement Academy: 25 Pushup (no time limit), 20 sit-ups in one minute, 1 mile run in 10 minutes, 300-meter sprint in 71 seconds, and 15-inch vertical leap from maximum reach. All applicants must meet minimum criteria established by Code of Virginia Section 15.2-1705.
