

NOTICE TO TOWN OF WYTHEVILLE WATER CUSTOMERS

The Town of Wytheville is receiving numerous inquiries regarding the need to boil water for the residents on the Town of Wytheville water system. If you receive a water bill from the Town of Wytheville there is, currently, **NO** need for you to boil your water for any use. The Virginia Department of Health (VDH) has **NOT** issued a notice to the Town requiring or requesting Wytheville's water customers to do so. If the situation were to change, the Town of Wytheville will notify its customers of the boil notice via the Town's website, Facebook page, Three Rivers Media radio, notices posted in the lobby of the Municipal Building, etc.

We would like to remind all water users that we are still asking for all non-essential water use to be curtailed as we recover from the weather event.
